Dear Parishioners:

In the almost eleven months that have I been your Pastor, there has been a lot of positive change and feedback from the community at large. In meetings with both the Finance Council and the Parish Council there is agreement that we need to move forward with our Mission Statement: "Bringing the Eucharistic Lord to all people by living the Gospel Message." This can only be done when the community acts as one in Jesus Christ with utmost charity and unity without malice or negativity.

The Parish Council has actively been working on a vision and development plan as we move forward in the next five years. They are comprised of four phases:

1. The Rectory
2. The Classrooms
3. Parish Offices
4. Margil Parish Center

This letter will speak to Phase 1 and its progress. In the past few years, the monthly building fund (now named building/renovation fund) and the Multicultural Festival has allowed for the complete renovation of the Rectory Main building. (Cottage #2 was renovated in August of 2016 through a generous gift of two parishioners). The process of renovation is more expensive than actually building a new Rectory but the Bishop wanted the integrity of the exterior to remain for the continued aesthetics of the parish plant. The Bishop signed a contract with the Cordova Construction Company to complete the renovation which we hope will be completed by the end of June and an open house held after all Masses for the parish community.

The purpose of renovating the rectory building was due to the fact of mold and mildew and rot suffered throughout the interior. The structure needed to be brought up to code so that it can house the priests of the parish in their ministry as well as provide more efficient use of the space with a functional kitchen.

As we near completion of Phase 1 we will both announce this from the pulpit and print details in the bulletin. On behalf of your priests, we are grateful for your patience and your past generosity to allow us to move forward in this endeavor. Shortly, I will communicate the progress and format of Phase 2.

Estimados Parroquianos

En el transcurso de estos once meses como su párroco, han tenido lugar una serie de cambios positivos y observaciones alentadoras por parte de la comunidad en general. En las reuniones con el consejo financiero y el consejo parroquial se ha evidenciado la necesidad de avanzar en nuestra misión: “Llevar al Señor Eucarístico a todas las personas, mediante la vivencia del mensaje del evangelio”. Esto solo podemos lograrlo cuando la comunidad actúa como una en Cristo Jesús motivada por la caridad y la unidad en donde no haya lugar para la malicia y la negatividad.

El consejo parroquial ha estado trabajando activamente en la visión parroquial y hoja de ruta para los próximos 5 años. Este plan se compone de cuatro etapas.

1. La rectoría
 2. Los salones de clase
 3. Oficinas parroquiales
- Centro Parroquial (Margil)

Esta carta se concentrara sobre la etapa 1 y su respectivo progreso. En los últimos cinco años, el fondo para la construcción (renombrado como: “fondo de construcción y renovación”) y el festival Multicultural nos permitieron la renovación total de la Rectoría (El *cottage* #2 fue renovado en Agosto de 2016, gracias a la generosa donación de uno de nuestros feligreses). El proceso de renovación es mucho mas costoso que construir una nueva rectoría. Sin embargo, el obispo deseaba mantener la integridad de la propiedad y de esta forma conservar la estética de toda la planta. El obispo firmó el contrato con la compañía constructora *Cordova* para la renovación, la cual esperamos este terminada para finales de Junio. Una vez terminada la renovación designaremos un día en el cual todos ustedes tendrán la oportunidad de visitar la rectoría y ver el proyecto finalizado.

La razón de la renovación se debió a la presencia de moho, mildiú y putrefacción al interior de la casa. La rectoría debía ser renovada para que cumpliera con las normativas actuales de la ciudad de Nacogdoches y de esta manera poder alojar a los sacerdotes que desempeñan y desempeñaran su ministerio en el futuro en esta parroquia. La renovación hace un uso más eficiente del espacio, y además provee una cocina totalmente funcional.

Una vez la etapa 1 este a punto de concluirse ambos nos encargaremos de anunciarlo desde el púlpito además de imprimir los detalles pertinentes en el boletín parroquial.

Les agradecemos su paciencia y su generosidad a lo largo de los últimos cinco años que nos permitieron llevar a cabo este proyecto. En un futuro cercano anunciaré el progreso de la etapa 2
